I have a health issue, what health services are available?



In an emergency situation, when a GP is not available, you can access the health services through your local hospital Emergency Department



Use GP Out of Hours Services for urgent medical care between 6.00pm and 8.00am Monday to Friday and 24 hours on Saturday, Sundays and Bank Holidays



Maternity Care (under Maternity and Infant Care Scheme)



Vaccinations, Blood tests, Family planning and other tests might be available

GENERAL PRACTITIONER SERVICE



TREATMENT FOR YOUR HEALTH ISSUE
(most health conditions are managed by GP)



In some cases, General Practitioner might refer you for further tests, such as X-Ray, Ultrasound or MRI



In some cases, General Practitioner might refer you to specialist health services or to hospital
